Confidence in Being Me Workshop for Younger People

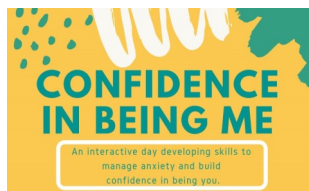
Saturday 6th April 2019 from 9:30am to 3pm - Floor 8, 1 Colmore Row, B3 2BJ
