### Inclusivity

Ken Howcroft, minister at Solihull Methodist Church, has been chairing the Methodist Conference's Task group on Marriage and Relationships, which began work in 2016. Its report "God in love unites us" has now been published this week on the Methodist Church website [www.methodist.org.uk](http://www.methodist.org.uk).

The report covers important, sensitive and difficult topics. Ken tells us that in the report, they try to correct the balance, so that we do not spend all our energy worrying about to whom we should relate, but pay attention to how we relate to people. We all live with a huge variety of relationships in our world; some closer and some more distant. Within our circles of friends, family and acquaintances, most of us will have at least some experience of conventional two-parent families, single parent families, co-habiting couples, single people, people who have divorced and re-married, same-sex partnerships, and many others.

So how do we best live, how do we live faithfully, how do we live in a holy way in and through our relationships today, including marriage?

We have tried to encourage and enable everyone to be open and positive, and to speak joyfully and wisely about sexuality and relationships.

The report invites everyone to recognise grace wherever it can be found, and to value all committed faithful loving relationships that bear the marks that we can see in the love of Jesus.

The report makes proposals that will enable us to continue together even when we disagree about how these things work out in practice.

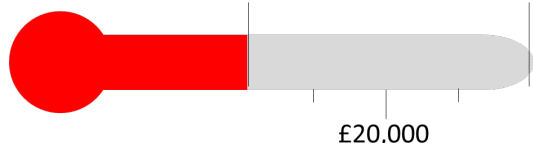
