Confidence in Being Me Workshop for Younger People

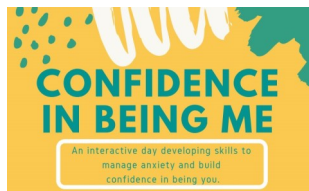
