Isaiah 61: 1-11

Isaiah's message points to a person who will bring liberation and healing to an oppressed and broken people. It's a message that would have brought joy and hope to the original audience. The people of Judah had been deported as prisoners, heartbroken by loss – loss of their land, their home, their loved ones, their way of life – and experiencing oppression under the hand of a harsh ruler. This is not the life they wanted.


