Green Tip

One of the most surprising statistics, given the relentless building of new roads and spread of cities, is to discover that the 10% of England's land surface now covered by woodland is about the same as at the time of the Black Death in the 14th century! Woodland areas have been increasing since the end of the 1st World War when it was only 5%.

This growth is important. Trees 'mop up' carbon dioxide, the main global warming, greenhouse gas. We need to replace trees at the end of their lives and add extra ones where there is space. And why not? Trees can bring flowers and/or fruit, provide shade and habitat for birds – and they are beautiful too.

Perry Hall car park update

We have been informed by Birmingham City Council that full planning consent will be required to replace the grassed area (currently used for parking) with grasscrete, a plastic interlocking honeycomb structure, enabling a grass cover in excess of 90%. We are currently taking advice on how to progress this in the most cost effective way.


