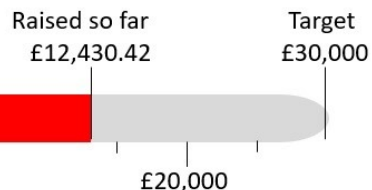
World Day of Prayer Service 2020
