#### Foodbank shortages - can you help?

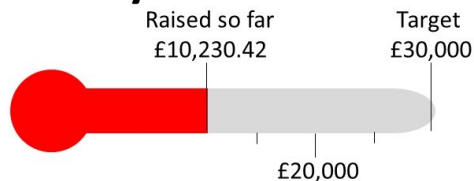
The food bank is desperately short of all items. Anything you can donate to help will be very, very much appreciated.
