One of the most surprising statistics, given the relentless building of new roads and spread of cities, is to discover that the 10% of England's land surface now covered by woodland is about the same as at the time of the Black Death in the 14th century! Woodland areas have been increasing since the end of the 1st World War when it was only 5%.

This growth is important. Trees 'mop up' carbon dioxide, the main global warming, greenhouse gas. We need to replace trees at the end of their lives and add extra ones where there is space. 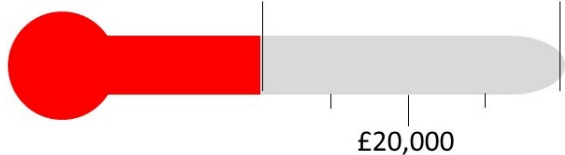
