Toy / Gift service - Sunday 8th December @10.45am



Green Tip

Councils say that shredded paper cannot be recycled because shredding leaves the paper fibres too short. It has to go in the general waste (black) bins. So only shred when really necessary.

It is still best to stuff paper that is shredded into a bag of some kind so that the strips don't fly away in the wind when the bins are lifted and emptied, but the bags don't have to be paper. If you have a compost bin, you always compost your shredded paper.


Foodbank shortages - can you help?
