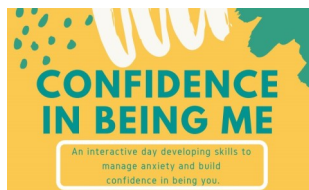


**Reimagine Church Conference 2019 at The Church at Carrs Lane**
